## **KEY CONCERNS RELATED TO THE JURISDICTION**

- A. There are several emergency situations that may require an evacuation of part or all of Burke County which consists of 1,129 square miles and its 2,242 citizens. Evacuations may be needed as a result of flood, hazardous material accident, fire, transportation, private industry mishaps or other accidents identified. The purpose of this document is to provide the framework the county needs to ensure the safe and orderly evacuation of residents who are threatened by hazards. It is important to note that 25.10% of the population is over 60 years of age and this creates additional concerns. Through a collaborative effort, each individual department or agency is responsible for planning how they will fulfill their assignments.
- B. Spontaneous evacuation will occur when there is sufficient warning of the threat. Between 5 to 20 percent of the people at risk will evacuate before being directed to do so.
- Some people will refuse to evacuate, regardless of the threat.

- Some owners of companion pets will refuse to evacuate unless arrangements have been made to care for their animals.
